8 9 AN ACT concerning certain documents of the secretary of health and 10 environment; amending K.S.A. 2002 Supp. 75-5662 and repealing the 11 existing section. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14 Section 1. K.S.A. 2002 Supp. 75-5662 is hereby amended to read as 15follows: 75-5662. (a) The secretary of health and environment shall pub- 16 lish make available on-line or upon request all general policies, guidelines, 17standards and other documents that are used by the division of environ-18 ment as part of the division's regulatory functions. The publication shall 19 be supplemented at least annually. The division of the environment shall 20make the publication available upon request for a fee to be fixed by the 21secretary in an amount which will recover only the cost incurred by the 22 division for printing and binding such materials, except that the fee for the original publication of all such documents shall not exceed \$75 and 2324the fee for the annual supplement shall not exceed \$15. The publication 25or supplement may incorporate by reference or contain a bibliographie listing of documents that are published or protected by copyright if such 26 27documents are generally available to the public or are provided by the 28division to any citizen upon request in accordance with the provisions of 29 K.S.A. 45-219 et seq., and amendments thereto. 30 (b) There is hereby established in the state treasury the health and 31 environment publication fee fund. All moneys received by the depart-32 ment of health and environment from fees received pursuant to subsee-33 tion (a) shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the 34 provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of 35 each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount 36 in the state treasury to the credit of the health and environment publieation fee fund. Moneys in such fund shall be used only for paying the 37 expenses of publishing documents as required by subsection (a). Ex-38 penditures from the fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation 39 acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant 40 to vouchers approved by the secretary of health and environment or a 41 42 person designated by the secretary.

43 (b) On the effective date of this act, any moneys in the health and

environment publication fee fund shall be transferred to the state general fund and the health and environment publication fee fund shall be and is

hereby abolished.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2002 Supp. 75-5662 is hereby repealed.Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its $\mathbf{5}$ publication in the statute book.
