AN ACT concerning appropriations for fiscal years June 30, 2005, and
June 30, 2006, for a pilot program for dependents of state employees;
amending K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 75-6506a and repealing the existing
section.

14 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

15Section 1. K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 75-6506a is hereby amended to read 16 as follows: 75-6506a. Commending in plan year 2002, Within the limits 17of appropriations thereof, the Kansas state employees health care com-18mission shall establish a pilot program which provides that, if an active 19 employee of the state of Kansas is enrolled in a health care benefits plan 20 administered by the Kansas state employees health care commission, pur-21 suant to K.S.A. 75-6501 et seq., and amendments thereto, the commission 22 shall provide that a percentage determined by the commission, within the 23 limits of appropriations for the pilot program, of the cost to cover an 24eligible child or children shall be paid as an employer contribution for 25the participation of any eligible child or children in the state health ben-26 efits program.

27 (b) As used in this section, "eligible child" means any child who is an 28eligible dependent pursuant to K.A.R. 108-1-1 and who is otherwise eli-29 gible for insurance coverage under the insurance plan authorized by 30 K.S.A. 38-2001 and amendments thereto and under the guidelines for 31 eligibility developed by the commission within the limits of appropriations 32 for the pilot program but is not eligible solely because the child is a 33 member of a family that is eligible for health benefits coverage under a 34 state health benefits plan administered by the Kansas state employees 35 health care commission. The state health care commission shall fix the 36 costs of participation under the pilot project prescribed to be conducted 37 by this section for eligible children, as defined by this subsection, of state 38 employees for plan year 2005.

(c) The Kansas state employees health care commission shall report
its findings and any recommendations which the commission may have
concerning the pilot program established under this section to the governor and to the legislature annually.

43 (d) The secretary of administration is hereby authorized to receive

grants, gifts or donations from the United States government, or its agen-1 cies, the Sunflower Foundation: Health care for Kansas, or any other 2 3 source whatsoever for the purposes of the pilot program established under this section and amendments thereto, and any moneys so received 4 shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to the cafeteria ben-5efits fund established by K.S.A. 75-6513 and amendments thereto. All 6 7 funds received pursuant to this section shall be placed in a separate account within the cafeteria benefits fund to be used for the pilot program. 8

9 (e)Expenditures shall be made from the cafeteria benefits fund for 10 fiscal years June 30, 2005, and June 30, 2006, from moneys available in 11 the fund for this purpose to conduct the pilot project prescribed by this section for plan year 2005. All expenditures made from such fund the 1213 *cafeteria benefits fund* for the purposes of this section shall be made in 14 accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of ac-15counts and reports issued by the secretary of administration or a person designated by the secretary of administration. 16

(f) The commission shall prepare and submit budget estimates for the 17plan year 2005 for the amount required to finance the costs of conducting 1819 this pilot project, in addition to the amounts available from gifts, grants 20 or donations received for this purpose, and submit such estimate to the governor and to the legislature. The legislature shall provide by appro-2122 priation act for the transfer of sufficient moneys during the fiscal years ending June 30, 2005, and June 30, 2006, from the children's initiatives 2324fund to the cafeteria benefits fund to finance the costs of conducting this 25pilot project.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 75-6506a is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the statute book.
