10 AN ACT concerning public water supply systems; relating to certain fees and the disposition thereof; amending K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 82a-2101 and 11 12repealing the existing section. 13 14Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 15Section 1. K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 82a-2101 is hereby amended to read 16 as follows: 82a-2101. (a) On and after January 1, 2002, there is hereby 17imposed a clean drinking water fee at the rate of \$.03 per 1,000 gallons 18of water sold at retail by a public water supply system and delivered 19 through mains, lines or pipes. Such fee shall be paid, administered, en-20forced and collected in the manner provided for the fee imposed by sub-21section (a)(1) of K.S.A. 82a-954, and amendments thereto. The price to 22 the consumer of water sold at retail by any such system shall not include 23 the amount of such fee. 24 (b) (1) A public water supply system may elect to opt out of the fee 25imposed by this section by notifying, before October 1, 2001, the Kansas 26 water office and the department of revenue of the election to opt out. 27*Except as provided by subsection* (b)(2), such election shall be irrevocable. 28Such public water supply system shall continue to pay all applicable sales 29tax on direct and indirect purchases of tangible personal property and 30 services purchased by such system. 31 On and after January 1, 2005, any public water supply system (2)32 which elected to opt out of the fee imposed by subsection (a) may elect to 33 collect such fee as provided by subsection (a) and direct and indirect 34 purchases of tangible personal property and services by such system shall 35 be exempt from sales tax as provided by K.S.A. 79-3606, and amendments 36 thereto. Such election shall be irrevocable. 37 The director of taxation shall remit to the state treasurer in ac-(c) 38 cordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto, 39 all moneys received or collected from the fee imposed pursuant to this 40 section. Upon receipt thereof, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury and credit 5/98 thereof it as follows: 4142(1)Before January 1, 2006, 5/98 2007, 5/106 of such amount shall be

2 (2) on and after January 1, 2006 2007, the entire amount shall be 3 credited to the state water plan fund created by K.S.A. 82a-951, and 4 amendments thereto, for use: (A) In protecting and renovating lakes which are used, directly or indirectly, as a source of water for public water $\mathbf{5}$ supply systems, as defined in K.S.A. 65-162a, and amendments thereto; 6 7 and (B) in providing water conservation programs, mapping of water systems, energy reduction for water treatment operations and on-site 8 9 technical and other assistance for such public water supply systems. Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 82a-2101 is hereby repealed. 10 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 11 12 publication in the statute book.
