AN ACT concerning the secretary of health and environment; providing
for the establishment of an electronic communicable disease reporting
system; establishing criteria for the system.

14 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

15 Section 1. (a) Within the limits of appropriations therefor, the sec-16 retary of health and environment shall establish a computer information 17 system of near real-time automated and electronic communicable disease 18 reporting which is designed to assist in the identification of potential 19 outbreaks of communicable disease or bioterrorism events and which pro-20 vides near real-time information to public health personnel and health 21 care providers.

22 (b) The electronic communicable disease reporting system shall be 23designed to: (1) Allow for importing data to existing systems; (2) shorten 24the communicable disease outbreak detection or identification cycle by 25decreasing manual data entry and reporting, thereby improving the time-26 liness of communicable disease reports; (3) increase the volume of re-27 porting of diseases and reduce under-reporting of diseases; (4) improve 28the quality of data collected by increasing the completeness of required 29 data fields; (5) provide automatic alerting to key individuals and agencies 30 of critical events such as identification of potential communicable disease 31 outbreaks or bioterrorism agents; (6) provide detailed reports for trend 32 analysis; (7) provide laboratory orders information to assist in early de-33 tection of potential outbreaks of communicable disease or bioterrorism 34 events; (8) provide reports simultaneously to authorized jurisdictions and 35 individuals; and (9) provide aggregate reports to contributing health care 36 providers including medical care facilities.

(c) The secretary of health and environment may adopt rules andregulations as necessary to carry out the provisions of this act.
