AN ACT concerning public funded health care; relating to disclosure of
 employers' names.

12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

13 Section 1. (a) Any applicant for health care provided under public 14 programs, including but not limited to medicaid, the state insurance cov-15erage for children program and any other health care program supported 16 by state funds, shall identify the employer or employers of the proposed 17beneficiary of the health care benefits. In the event the proposed bene-18 ficiary is not employed, the applicant shall identify the employer or em-19 ployers of any adult responsible for providing all or some of the proposed 20 beneficiary's support.

21 (b) On or before January 30 of each year, the secretary of social and 22 rehabilitation services shall submit to the state legislature a report listing 23 the names of all employers identified pursuant to the application require-24ments in subsection (a). The report shall include each company's name, 25addresses and the total number of such company's employees and de-26 pendents who are enrolled in each state health care program. No other 27 information regarding program beneficiaries shall be included in this report. 28

(c) For the purposes of this act, the required report in subsection (b)
shall be a public record open to inspection by the public under the open
records act, K.S.A. 45-215 *et seq.*, and amendments thereto.

32 (d) As used in this act, the term "proposed beneficiary" means any 33 individual who files an application for benefits for such individual, or any 34 other individual on whose behalf an application is filed, including but not 35 limited to, children or other dependents of the applicant or other indi-36 vidual for whom the application is filed.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the statute book.
