AN ACT concerning the emergency medical services board; relating to
financial support thereof; amending K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 75-1508 and
repealing the existing section.

13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

14 Section 1. K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 75-1508 is hereby amended to read as 15follows: 75-1508. (a) For the purpose of maintaining the department of 16 the state fire marshal and the payment of the expenses incident thereto, 17each fire insurance company doing business in this state shall pay to the 18commissioner of insurance, on or before March 15 each year, beginning 19 with the year 1984, and each year thereafter, in addition to the taxes, fees 20 and charges now required by law to be paid by it, such levy as may be 21 made by the state fire marshal. The levy shall not be more than 1.0% for 22 calendar years 2002 and 2003 through 2008, and 1.25% for calendar year 23 2004 2009 and ensuing years, of a sum equal to the gross cash receipts 24as premiums of such company on all fire business transacted by it in the 25state of Kansas during the calendar year next preceding, as shown by its 26 annual statement under oath to the state insurance department.

27 (b) For the purposes of maintaining the emergency medical services 28board and the payment of the expenses incident thereto, each fire insur-29 ance company doing business in this state shall pay to the commissioner 30 of insurance, on or before March 15 each year, beginning with calendar 31 year 2002 and ending with calendar year 2003 2008, in addition to the 32 taxes, fees and charges now required by law to be paid by it, such levy as 33 may be made by the emergency medical services board. The levy shall 34 not be more than .25% of a sum equal to the gross cash receipts as 35 premiums of such company on all fire business transacted by it in the 36 state of Kansas during the calendar year next preceding, as shown by its 37 annual statement under oath to the state insurance department. The pro-38 visions of this subsection (b) shall expire on July 1, 2004 2009.

39 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 75-1508 is hereby repealed.

40 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 41 publication in the Kansas register.

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
