AN ACT concerning crime victims information; amending K.S.A. 747338 and K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 22-4909 and repealing the existing
sections.

13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

14 Section 1. K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 22-4909 is hereby amended to read as 15follows: 22-4909. The statements or any other information required by 16 this the Kansas offender registration act shall be open to inspection by 17the public at the sheriff's office, at the headquarters of the Kansas bureau 18 of investigation and on any internet website sponsored or created by a 19 sheriff's department or the Kansas bureau of investigation that contains 20 such statements or information, and specifically are subject to the pro-21visions of the Kansas open records act, K.S.A. 45-215 et seq., and amendments thereto, except that the name, address, telephone number, or any 22 23other information which specifically and individually identifies the victim 24of any offender required to register as provided in this the Kansas offender 25registration act shall not be disclosed other than to law enforcement agen-26 cies and the secretary of social and rehabilitation services.

27 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 74-7338 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-287338. (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 74-7335 and amend-29 ments thereto, in the case of any inmate convicted of an off-grid felony 30 or a class A felony, the secretary of corrections shall give written notice 31 of the time and place of the public comment session pursuant to K.S.A. 32 22-3717 and amendments thereto for such inmate, at least one month 33 preceding the public comment session, to any victim or the victim's family 34 pursuant to subsection (b).

(b) Any victim, or a member of the victim's family of a crime, if such victim requests notice of the public comment session, shall give the secretary of corrections such victim's name and current address or the name and current address of the victim's family. It shall be the duty of the victim or the victim's family to provide the secretary with any change in name or address or change in the person to be notified pursuant to this section.
