## HOUSE BILL No. 2640

AN ACT concerning primary elections; pertaining to a limitation on the number of such elections; amending K.S.A. 25-2021, 25-2108a and 711415 and repealing the existing sections.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
Section 1. K.S.A. 25-2021 is hereby amended to read as follows: 252021. (a) In school districts in which a member district method of election is in effect, if there are more than (2) three qualified candidates for one (1) member position in any member district, the county election officer shall call, and there shall be held, a primary election in each such member district and, if there are more than (2) three qualified candidates for the at-large member position, the county election officer shall call, and there shall be held, a primary election in such school district. The If a primary election is held, the names of the two (2) candidates receiving the greatest number of votes for any member position at the primary election shall appear on the ballots in the general election.
(b) In school districts having the election at large method, if there are more than two (2) times the number of candidates as there are board members to be elected, the county election officer shall call, and there shall be held, a primary election. The names of twice the number of candidates as there are board members to be elected who received the greatest number of votes at the primary election shall appear on the ballots in the general election.
(c) If a member is to be elected to fill an unexpired term the rules in this section shall be modified consistent with the provisions of this subsection. If there are more than (2) three candidates for such unexpired term, the county election officer shall call and there shall be held, a primary election. The If a primary election is held, the names of the two (2) candidates for such unexpired term receiving the greatest number of votes shall appear on the ballots in the general election.
(d) No ballot in a primary school election shall have either names or write-in blanks for any board member position unless more than (2) three candidates have filed for such position. If there are three or fewer candidates, the names of all candidates shall appear on the ballots in the general election.
(e) On the ballots in general school elections, blank lines for the name of write-in candidates shall be printed at the end of the list of candidates for each different office equal to the number to be elected thereto. The purpose of such blank lines shall be to permit the voter to insert the name of any person not printed on the ballot for whom such voter desires to vote for such office. No lines for write-in candidates shall appear on primary school election ballots.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 25-2108a is hereby amended to read as follows: 252108a. (a) There shall be a primary election of city officers on the Tuesday preceding by five weeks the first Tuesday in April of every year that such city has a city election, except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of this section.
(b) No primary election of city officers shall be held unless by holding such primary one (1) two or more persons will be eliminated as candidates for office. In the event there are not more than (2) three candidates for any one office, the names of the candidates for such office shall not appear on the primary election ballots, and there shall be no primary election for such office, but the names of such candidates shall be placed on the general city election ballot.

Sec. 3. K.S.A. 71-1415 is hereby amended to read as follows: 711415. (a) In any college district having a district method and in which there are more than three qualified candidates for a member position, the election officer shall call, and there shall be held, a primary election in each such member district. If there are more than three qualified candidates for the at-large member position, the election officer shall call, and there shall be held, a primary election for the at-large member position. The If a primary election is held, the names of the two candidates receiving the greatest number of votes for any member position shall appear on the ballots in the general election.
(b) In any college district having the election-at-large method and in which there are more than two times the number of candidates as there are trustees to be elected, the election officer shall call, and there shall be held, a primary election. The names of twice the number of candidates as there are trustees to be elected who receive the greatest number of votes in the primary shall appear on the ballots in the general election.
(c) In the general election, there shall appear on the ballots a line appropriate for write-in candidates. No lines for write-in candidates shall appear on the primary election ballots.

Sec. 4. K.S.A. 25-2021, 25-2108a and 71-1415 are hereby repealed.
Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
