8 9 AN ACT concerning wage payment; relating to electronic deposit 10 thereof; amending K.S.A. 44-314 and 75-5540 and repealing the ex-11 isting sections. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14 Section 1. K.S.A. 44-314 is hereby amended to read as follows: 44-15 314. (a) Every employer shall pay all wages due to the employees of the 16 employer at least once during each calendar month, on regular paydays 17designated in advance by the employer, in lawful money of the United 18 States or with checks or drafts which are negotiable in the community 19 wherein the place of employment is located or, with the written consent 20of the employee, by electronic deposit to an employee's account at a 21 financial institution. 22 (b) The end of the pay period for which payment is made on a regular 23 payday shall be not more than 15 days before such regular payday unless 24a variance in such requirement is authorized by state or federal law. 25Sec. 2. K.S.A. 75-5540 is hereby amended to read as follows: 75-26 5540. As part of the system of payroll accounting formulated under K.S.A.

27 75-5501, and amendments thereto, the director of accounts and reports 28 shall develop and authorize a payroll remittance plan which will allow the 29 salaries and wages of state officers or employees to be deposited directly 30 to the accounts of such officers or employees, in banks, savings and loan 31 associations or credit unions. Such direct deposits shall be made only 32 upon the written authorization and direction of such state officers or 33 employees.

34 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 44-314 and 75-5540 are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
