HOUSE BILL No. 2673

An Act concerning claims; relating to prior fiscal year claims for services or purchases by state agencies; amending K.S.A. 46-923 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 46-923 is hereby amended to read as follows: 46-923. Notwithstanding K.S.A. 75-3731, and amendments thereto, the director of accounts and reports shall accept for payment from the head of any state agency any claim not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500) \$5,000 for services or purchases even though such claim was not submitted or processed for payment within the fiscal year in which the service was rendered or the purchase was made except that. No claim filed more than six months after the time date that the service was rendered or the purchase was made shall be allowed or paid.
