10 AN ACT concerning [state finance; relating to] the governor's budget 11 report [and appropriation bills]; excluding certain transfers from 12special revenue funds to state general fund; amending K.S.A. 2003 13 Supp. 75-3721 and repealing the existing section. 1415Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 16Section 1. K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 75-3721 is hereby amended to read as 17follows: 75-3721. (a) On or before the eighth calendar day of each regular 18 legislative session, the governor shall submit the budget report to the 19 legislature, except that in the case of the regular legislative session im-20mediately following the election of a governor who was elected to the 21office of governor for the first time, that governor shall submit the budget 22 report to the legislature on or before the 21st calendar day of that regular 23 legislative session. 24 (b) The budget report of the governor shall be set up in three parts, 25the nature and contents of which shall include the following: 26Part one shall consist of a budget message by such governor, in-(1)27cluding the governor's recommendations with reference to the fiscal pol-28icy of the state government for the current fiscal year and the ensuing 29fiscal year, describing the important features of the budget plan for each 30 of the fiscal years included, embracing a general budget summary setting 31 forth the aggregate figures of the budget so as to show the balanced 32 relation between the total proposed expenditures and the total anticipated 33 income for the current fiscal year and the ensuing fiscal year, with the 34 basis and factors upon which the estimates were made, and the means of 35 financing the budget plan for the each of the fiscal years included, com-36 pared with the corresponding figures for at least the last completed fiscal 37 year, and the director of the budget shall prepare the figures for the 38 governor for such comparisons. 39 (A) The budget plan shall not include (i) any proposed expenditures 40 of anticipated income attributable to proposed legislation that would pro-41vide additional revenues from either current or new sources of revenue, 42or (ii) any proposed expenditures of moneys in the ending balance in the

43 state general fund required by K.S.A. 75-6702, and amendments thereto,

or (iii) any transfer, including any authorization or direction to transfer,
 of any moneys from any special revenue fund to the state general fund if
 existing law does not provide for moneys in such special revenue fund to
 be transferred.
 (B) The general budget summary may be supported by explanatory
 schedules or statements, classifying the expenditures contained therein

by state agencies, objects, and funds, and the income by state agencies,
funds, sources and types. The general budget summary shall include all
special or fee funds as well as the state general fund, and shall include
the estimated amounts of federal aids, for whatever purpose provided,
together with estimated expenditures therefrom.

12(2)Part two shall embrace the detailed budget estimates for each of 13 the fiscal years included, both of expenditures and revenues, showing the 14requests of the state agencies, if any, and the incoming governor's rec-15ommendations thereon. It shall also include statements of the bonded 16 indebtedness of the state, showing the actual amount of the debt service 17for at least the last completed fiscal year, and the estimated amount for 18the current fiscal year and for each of the ensuing fiscal years included, 19 the debt authorized and unissued, and the condition of the sinking funds. 20Part three shall consist of a draft of a legislative measure or meas-(3)21ures reflecting the incoming governor's budget for all of the fiscal years 22 included in the budget report.

(c) The division of the budget shall compile a children's budget document consisting of the information contained in agency budget estimates
regarding programs that provide services for children and their families.
Such document shall be provided to the Kansas commission on children,
youth and families, established by the governor's executive order number
91-145, and other persons or entities on request.

(d) The division of the budget, upon request, shall furnish the governor or the legislature with any further information required concerning
the budget.

32 (e) Nothing in this section shall be construed to restrict or limit the 33 privilege of the governor to present supplemental budget messages or 34 amendments to previous budget messages, which may include proposals 35 for expenditure of new or increased sources of revenue derived from 36 proposed legislation or transfers from special revenue funds to the state 37 general fund that are not provided for in existing law.

(f) The budget estimate for the judicial branch of state government
as submitted to the director of the budget pursuant to K.S.A. 20-158, and
amendments thereto, shall be included in the governor's budget report.
