K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 75-4364 is hereby amended to read as 15follows: 75-4364. (a) As used in this section: 16 (1) "Kansas educational institution" means and includes area voca-17tional schools, area vocational-technical schools, community colleges, the 18municipal university, state educational institutions, and technical colleges. 19 (2)"Public safety officer" means a law enforcement officer or a fire-20fighter or an emergency medical services attendant. 21"Law enforcement officer" means a person who by virtue of office (3)22 or public employment is vested by law with a duty to maintain public 23order or to make arrests for violation of the laws of the state of Kansas 24or ordinances of any municipality thereof or with a duty to maintain or 25assert custody or supervision over persons accused or convicted of crime, 26 and includes wardens, superintendents, directors, security personnel, of-27 ficers and employees of adult and juvenile correctional institutions, jails 28or other institutions or facilities for the detention of persons accused or 29 convicted of crime, while acting within the scope of their authority. 30 "Firefighter" means a person who is: (1) Employed by any city, (4)31 county, township or other political subdivision of the state and who is 32 assigned to the fire department thereof and engaged in the fighting and 33 extinguishment of fires and the protection of life and property therefrom; 34 or (2) a volunteer member of a fire district, fire department or fire 35 company. 36 "Emergency medical services attendant" means a first responder, (5)37 emergency medical technician, emergency medical technician-interme-38 diate, emergency medical technician-defibrillator or a mobile intensive 39 care technician certified by the emergency medical services board pur-40 suant to the statutory provisions contained in article 61 of chapter 65 of 41 Kansas Statutes Annotated. 42 "Dependent" means (A) a birth child, adopted child or stepchild (6)43 of a public safety officer or (B) any child other than the foregoing who is 3

actually dependent in whole or in part on a public safety officer and who
 is related to the public safety officer by marriage or consanguinity.

(7) "State board" means the state board of regents.

4 (b) Every Kansas educational institution shall provide for enrollment $\mathbf{5}$ without charge of tuition or fees for any dependent *or spouse* of a public 6 safety officer who died as the result of injury sustained while performing 7 duties as a public safety officer so long as such dependent or spouse is 8 eligible. Any such dependent or spouse shall be eligible for enrollment at 9 a Kansas educational institution without charge of tuition or fees for not 10to exceed eight semesters of undergraduate instruction, or the equivalent 11 thereof, at all such institutions, in the aggregate, for any such dependent 12 or spouse.

13 (c) Subject to appropriations therefor, any Kansas educational insti-14 tution, at which enrollment, without charge of tuition or fees, of the de-15pendent or spouse of a deceased public safety officer is provided for under 16subsection (b), may file a claim with the state board for reimbursement 17of the amount of such tuition and fees. The state board shall be respon-18 sible for payment of reimbursements to Kansas educational institutions 19 upon certification by each such institution of the amount of reimburse-20ment to which entitled. Payments to Kansas educational institutions shall 21be made upon vouchers approved by the state board and upon warrants 22 of the director of accounts and reports. Payments may be made by issu-23ance of a single warrant to each Kansas educational institution at which 24one or more eligible dependents or spouses are enrolled for the total 25amount of tuition and fees not charged eligible dependents or spouses 26for enrollment at that institution. The director of accounts and reports 27shall cause such warrant to be delivered to the Kansas educational insti-28tution at which any such eligible dependent or dependents or spouses are 29enrolled. If an eligible dependent or spouse discontinues attendance be-30 fore the end of any semester, after the Kansas educational institution has 31 received payment under this subsection, the institution shall pay to the 32 state the entire amount which such eligible dependent *or spouse* would 33 otherwise qualify to have refunded, not to exceed the amount of the 34 payment made by the state in behalf of such dependent or spouse for the 35 semester. All amounts paid to the state by Kansas educational institutions 36 under this subsection shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited 37 to the state general fund.

(d) The state board shall adopt rules and regulations for administration of the provisions of this section and shall determine the qualification
of persons as dependents *and spouses* of public safety officers and the
eligibility of such persons for the benefits provided for under this section.
