9 AN ACT concerning alcoholic liquor; relating to retailers' licenses; 10 amending K.S.A. 41-308 and repealing the existing section. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 41-308 is hereby amended to read as follows: 41-14308. (a) A retailer's license shall allow the licensee to sell and offer for 15sale at retail and deliver in the original package, as therein prescribed, 16 alcoholic liquor for use or consumption off of and away from the premises 17specified in such license. A retailer's license shall permit sale and delivery 18 of alcoholic liquor only on the licensed premises and shall not permit sale 19 of alcoholic liquor for resale in any form, except that a licensed retailer 20 may: 21(1)Sell alcoholic liquor to a temporary permit holder for resale by 22 such permit holder; and 23(2) sell and deliver alcoholic liquor to a caterer or to the licensed 24premises of a club or drinking establishment, if such premises are in the 25county where the retailer's premises are located or in an adjacent county, 26 for resale by such club, establishment or caterer. 27 (b) The holder of a retailer's license shall not sell, offer for sale, give 28away or permit to be sold, offered for sale or given away in or from the 29 premises specified in such license any service or thing of value whatsoever 30 except alcoholic liquor in the original package, except that a licensed 31 retailer may: 32 - (1) Charge a delivery fee for delivery to a club, drinking establishment 33 or eaterer pursuant to subsection (a); 34 - (2) sell lottery tickets and shares to the public in accordance with the 35 Kansas lottery act, if the retailer is selected as a lottery retailer; 36 -(3) include in the sale of alcoholic liquor any goods included by the 37 manufacturer in packaging with the alcoholic liquor, subject to the ap-38 proval of the director; and 39 (4) distribute to the public, without charge, consumer advertising 40 specialities bearing advertising matter, subject to rules and regulations of 41 the secretary limiting the form and distribution of such specialities so that 42 they are not conditioned on or an inducement to the purchase of alcoholie 43 liquor.

1 -(e)(b) No licensed retailer shall furnish any entertainment in such 2 premises or permit any pinball machine or game of skill or chance to be 3 located in or on such premises.

4 (d) (c) A retailer's license shall allow the licensee to store alcoholic 5 liquor in refrigerators, cold storage units, ice boxes or other cooling de-6 vices, and the licensee may sell such alcoholic liquor to consumers in a 7 chilled condition.

8 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 41-308 is hereby repealed.

9 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 10 publication in the statute book.
