11	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
12	Section 1. (a) If two interest rates apply to an outstanding credit card
13	balance, the issuer of such credit card, as defined in K.S.A. 16a-1-301,
14	and amendments thereto, shall provide notice to the credit card holder,
15	in the monthly statement, that any payment received by the credit card
16	issuer from the credit card holder shall be applied against the balance
17	subject to the lower of the two interest rates first. Such notice shall be in

- at least 10 point bold face type.

 (b) Failure to comply with the provisions of this section shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,500.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
