9 AN ACT concerning imitation firearms; amending K.S.A. 12-16,115 and 10 repealing the existing section. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 12-16,115 is hereby amended to read as follows: 12-16,115. (a) Any person who sells, manufactures or distributes an imi-1415tation firearm in violation of this section shall be liable for a civil penalty 16in an action brought by the city attorney of the city or the county or district 17attorney of the county of not more than \$10,000 for each violation. Pen-18alties recovered pursuant to this section shall be deposited in the general 19 fund of the city or county. 20(b) The sale, manufacture or distribution of imitation firearms shall 21be permissible if the imitation firearm is sold, manufactured or distributed: 22 23 (1)Solely for export in interstate or foreign commerce; 24 (2)solely for lawful use in theatrical productions, including motion 25picture, television and stage productions; 26 for use in a certified or regulated athletic event or competition; (3)27 (4)for use in military or civil defense activities; or 28(5)for public displays authorized by public or private schools. 29(c) As used in this section, the term "imitation firearm" means a rep-30 lica of a firearm which is so substantially similar in physical properties to 31 an existing firearm as to lead a reasonable person to conclude that the 32 replica is a firearm. The term "imitation firearm" does not include: (1) A 33 nonfiring collector's replica of an antique firearm which was designed 34 prior to 1898, is historically significant, and is offered for sale in conjunc-35 tion with a wall plaque or presentation case; (2) a nonfiring collector's 36 replica of a firearm which was designed after 1898, is historically signif-37 icant, was issued as a commemorative by a nonprofit organization and is 38 offered for sale in conjunction with a wall plaque or presentation case; or 39 (3) a pneumatic, spring, spring-air or compressed-gas powered nonpow-40 der gun that is commonly called an air gun and is designed to discharge 41 BB's, pellets or paint balls, unless such gun is manufactured in such a 42form or with such attention to detail as to lead a reasonable person to 43 conclude that the replica is a firearm.
