9 AN ACT concerning the Kansas apprenticeship council; amending 10 K.S.A. 44-661 and repealing the existing section. 11 12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 44-661 is hereby amended to read as follows: 44-661. (a) There is hereby established the Kansas apprenticeship council 1415within the department of human resources. The Kansas apprenticeship 16 council shall be composed of nine members as follows: 17(1)Four members representative of management appointed by the 18secretary of human resources; 19 (2)four members representative of labor appointed by the secretary 20of human resources; and 21(3)the secretary of human resources or the secretary's designee. 22 In making such appointments, the secretary of human resources shall 23 consider all persons nominated for membership on the council by state-24 wide trade associations, employer groups and state labor organizations. 25All members appointed or designated by the secretary of human re-26 sources shall possess considerable knowledge of apprenticeship and ap-27prenticeship programs. 28(b) The terms of the four current members representing management 29and the four current members representing labor shall expire on February 30 29, 2004. For terms beginning March 1, 2004, the secretary of human 31 resources shall appoint one representative of management and one rep-32 resentative of labor to terms of one year, one representative of manage-33 ment and one representative of labor to terms of two years, one represen-34 tative of management and one representative of labor to terms of three 35 years and one representative of management and one representative of 36 labor to terms of four years. Thereafter members appointed by the sec-37 retary of human resources shall be appointed to four-year terms and shall 38 serve until their successors are appointed and qualified. A quorum shall 39 consist of any five members other than the secretary or the secretary's 40 designee. Each member shall have one vote on all matters before the 41council, except that the secretary or the secretary's designee may cast a 42vote only in cases of tie votes. Any vacancy shall be filled by appointment 43 for the remainder of the unexpired term.

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(c) The Kansas apprenticeship council shall organize annually by 1 2 electing a chairperson and a vice-chairperson from among the members 3 appointed by the secretary of human resources as representative of man-4 agement or labor. When a member representative of labor is chairperson $\mathbf{5}$ of the council, a member representative of management shall be vice-6 chairperson. When a member representative of management is chairper-7 son of the council, a member representative of labor shall be vice-chair-8 person. In the absence of the chairperson, the vice-chairperson shall 9 exercise all powers of the chairperson. The council may adopt such rules 10 of procedure as it may deem to be required for operation.

11 (d) The Kansas apprenticeship council shall meet regularly on a bi-12 monthly basis and at such other times as determined by the council. 13 Meetings may be held at locations within the state which will best pro-14mote the purposes of the council and apprenticeship and as may be re-15quired in the performance of the powers, duties and functions of the 16 council. Members of the Kansas apprenticeship council attending meet-17ings thereof, or attending a subcommittee meeting thereof authorized by 18 the council, shall be paid amounts provided in subsection (e) of K.S.A. 19 75-3223 and amendments thereto. Such amounts shall be paid pursuant 20to vouchers approved by the chairperson of the Kansas apprenticeship 21council and by the secretary of human resources or a person or persons 22 designated therefor by the secretary. 23 The secretary of human resources shall provide to the Kansas (e)

apprenticeship council such clerical, secretarial and other staff assistance
as may be requested by the council for the performance of the powers,
duties and functions of the council.
