9 AN ACT concerning state officers and employees; relating to legal holi-10 days for state service. 11 12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. (a) Commencing on and after January 1, 2005, the follow-14ing shall be legal holidays for state service for officers and employees of 15a state agency: (1) New Year's Day, January 1; 16(2)birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr., the third Monday in January; 17(3)birthday of George Washington, the third Monday in February; 18(4)Memorial Day, the last Monday in May; 19 (5)Independence Day, July 4; 20 (6)Labor Day, the first Monday in September; 21(7)Columbus Day, the second Monday in October; 22 (8)Veterans' Day, November 11; 23 (9)Thanksgiving Day holidays, the fourth Thursday and Friday in 24 November; and 25(10)Christmas Day, December 25. 26 The governor may designate additional legal holidays for state (b) service and in a particular year may designate additional days on which 2728state agency offices are to be closed in observance of a state holiday or a 29holiday season. For the purpose of this act, such a day is termed a legal 30 holiday for state service. 31 (c) The designation of legal holidays for state service as provided in 32 this act shall be construed in accordance with rules and regulations 33 adopted pursuant to existing statutory authority not in conflict with the 34 provisions of this act. 35 (d) As used in this section: (1) "Legal holiday for state service" means 36 any state holiday as provided in subsection (a) upon which a state officer 37 or employee may be absent from work with compensation; 38 "officers and employees" means any person who is an elected or (2)39 appointed officer or any employee of the state in the classified service or 40 unclassified service under the Kansas civil service act; and 41 "state agency" means any state office or officer, department, (3)42board, commission, institution, bureau or any agency, division or unit 43 within any office, department, board or other state authority or any person

- requesting a state appropriation. Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
