9 AN ACT concerning the crime victims funds; amending K.S.A. 74-7336 10 and repealing the existing section. 11 12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 74-7336 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-147336. (a) Of the remittances of fines, penalties and forfeitures received 15from clerks of the district court, at least monthly, the state treasurer shall 16 credit 7.99% 8.99% to the crime victims compensation fund, 1.45% 2.45% 17to the crime victims assistance fund, 2.01% to the community alcoholism 18 and intoxication programs fund, 2.01% to the department of corrections 19 alcohol and drug abuse treatment fund. The remainder of the remittances 20 shall be credited to the state general fund. 21The county treasurer shall deposit grant moneys as provided in (b) 22 subsection (a), from the crime victims assistance fund, to the credit of a 23 special fund created for use by the county or district attorney in estab-24 lishing and maintaining programs to aid witnesses and victims of crime. 25Sec. 2. K.S.A. 74-7336 is hereby repealed. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 26 Sec. 3. 27 publication in the statute book.
