(a) As used in this act, for livestock prepared in Kansas in 29accordance with the federal meat inspection act, 21 U.S.C.A. 601 et seq.: 30 (1) "Producer" means any person engaged in the business of breeding, 31 grazing, maintenance or feeding of livestock; 32 (2) "livestock" means cattle, sheep, swine, goats, horses, mules or 33 other equines; 34 (3)"meat food product" means the same as provided in 21 U.S.C.A. 35 601(j) et seq.; and 36 (4)"prepared" means the same as provided in 21 U.S.C.A. 601 (1) 37 et seq. 38 (b) In any action arising as a result of consumption of a meat food 39 product, there shall be no liability asserted or found against the producer of livestock, if the livestock in question was inspected and passed in ac-40cordance with the provisions of 21 U.S.C.A. 601 et seq. 4142Sec. 3.
