## HOUSE BILL No. 2945

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9 AN ACT relating to technical colleges; amending K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 72-10 4470a and repealing the existing section. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 72-4470a is hereby amended to read 14as follows: 72-4470a. (a) Subject to the provisions of subsection (d), on or 15before July 1, 2005, all technical college boards shall develop and present 16to the state board of regents a plan to replace the governing body de-17scribed in K.S.A. 72-4470, and amendments thereto, with a new govern-18 ing board, which shall be separate and independent of any board of ed-19 ucation of any school district, to operate, control and manage the technical 20college. The plan shall include, but not be limited to, provisions relating 21to: 22 (1)The composition of the independent governing board; 23 (2)the territory of the technical college. If the territory of the tech-24nical college includes more than one county, the plan shall designate a 25home county; 26 (3)the method of election or appointment and the terms of service 27of the members of the independent governing board; 28(4)the date upon which the independent governing board shall as-29sume management and control of the technical college; 30 the manner, terms upon which and extent to which the facilities, (5)31 will be transferred to the independent governing board and the division 32 of other assets and indebtedness and other liabilities; and 33 the manner and terms upon which faculty, employees and stu-(6)34 dents will be transferred to the independent governing board. Subject to 35 the provisions of K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 72-4478, and amendments thereto, 36 such provisions shall specify terms of employment and address other per-37 sonnel matters. 38 Upon approval of the plan by the state board of regents and (b) (1) 39 the governing body of the technical college which submitted the plan, 40and on the date determined in the approved plan, the independent gov-41erning board established under subsection (a) of this section shall operate 42subject to the rules, regulations and supervision of the state board of 43 regents in the same manner as other technical colleges, technical schools 1 and area vocational technical schools.

2 (2)Subject to the provisions of subsection (d), after June 30, 2007, if 3 the governing body of the technical college and the state board of regents 4 have not approved a plan submitted pursuant to subsection (a), the state 5board of regents shall have the power to approve the plan and upon such 6 approval and on the date determined in the approved plan, the inde-7 pendent governing board established pursuant to subsection (a) shall op-8 erate subject to the rules, regulations and supervision of the state board 9 of regents in the same manner as other technical colleges, technical 10 schools and area vocational technical schools.

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(c) In addition to such other powers expressly granted by law and
subject to the provisions of subsection (b), the governing board shall have
the power to:

14 (1) Determine the vocational, technology and general education
15 courses of instruction that will comprise the associate of applied science
16 degree programs of the college;

(2) establish the requirements for satisfactory completion of the as-sociate of applied science degree programs of the college;

(3) confer the associate of applied science degree upon students who
successfully complete an associate of applied science degree program of
the college and to award a certificate or diploma to students who successfully complete a vocational education program of the college; and

(4) appoint teaching staff and to fix and determine teacher qualifications, duties and compensation. No teacher appointed to teach courses
comprising the associate of applied science degree programs of the college shall be required to meet certification requirements greater than
those required in the state educational institutions.

(d) The provisions of this section shall apply only to technical colleges
that have sent to the state board of regents a resolution adopted on or
after July 1, 2004, that notifies the state board of regents that the govern-

31 ing body of the technical college has approved having the technical college

32 be covered by the provisions of this section. If the governing body of a

33 technical college on July 1, 2003, was the board of education of a school

34 district, such school district board is the only governing body which may

35 grant the approval specified by this subsection.

36 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 72-4470a is hereby repealed.
