A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the Congress of the United States to create a uniform federal drug coverage program.

WHEREAS, The cost of prescription drugs continues to rise; and WHEREAS, Amounts spent on prescription drugs has increased more rapidly than spending on other healthcare services with prescription drug

expenditures growing at double digit rates; and WHEREAS, Amounts spent on prescription drugs has significantly increased due to higher cost of prescription drugs and to increased utilization of prescription drugs; and

WHEREAS, Recent trends show that spending increases on prescription drugs will continue and are predicted to accelerate; and

WHEREAS, Prescription drugs are becoming more and more important in the treatment of many diseases; and

WHEREAS, More and more Kansas citizens, especially senior citizens, are finding it harder and harder to pay the costs of much needed prescription or maintenance drugs: Now, therefore;

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas, the Senate concurring therein: That the Kansas Legislature urges the Congress of the United States to create a uniform federal drug coverage program; and

Be it further resolved: That the Secretary of State is hereby directed to provided an enrolled copy of this resolution to the President pro tempore of the United States Senate, to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives and to each member of the Kansas Congressional Delegation.
