2 **House Concurrent Resolution No. 5022** 3 4 $\mathbf{5}$ By Representative Barbieri-Lightner 6 7 11 - 198 9 A PROPOSITION to amend article 11 of the constitution of the state of 10 Kansas by adding a new section thereto, prohibiting the increase of 11 the rate of certain taxes. 12 13 Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Kansas, two-thirds of the 14 members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the House of Repre-15 sentatives and two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and 16 qualified to the Senate concurring therein: 17Section 1. The following proposition to amend the constitution of the 18 state of Kansas shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the state 19 for their approval or rejection: Article 11 of the constitution of the state 20 of Kansas is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to read as 21 follows: 22 "§ 14. Prohibition against tax rate increases. No enactment 23 of the legislature shall: (a) Increase the rate of any tax imposed prior 24 to November 2, 2004; (b) impose a new tax after November 2, 2004; 25or (c) increase the rate of any tax described by clause (b), without 26 the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected (or ap-27 pointed) and qualified to the House of Representatives and two-28 thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the 29 Senate." 30 Sec. 2. The following statement shall be printed on the ballot with 31 the amendment as a whole: 32 "Explanatory statement. This amendment would establish a prohi-33 bition against general tax rate increases. "A vote for this proposition would establish a prohibition against 34 35 increases of the rate of any tax which was imposed prior to Novem-36 ber 2, 2004, or the imposition or the increase of the rate of a tax 37 newly imposed after November 2, 2004, without a two-thirds affirmative vote of the members of the House of Representatives and 38 39 the Senate. 40 "A vote against this proposition would maintain the absence of any tax levy rate increase limitation in the constitution." 41 42 Sec. 3. This resolution, if approved by two-thirds of the members

43 elected (or appointed) and qualified to the House of Representatives and

two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the Senate, shall be entered on the journals, together with the yeas and nays.

The secretary of state shall cause this resolution to be published as pro-

vided by law and shall cause the proposed amendment to be submitted to the electors of the state at the general election to be held on November $\mathbf{5}$
