House Concurrent Resolution No. 5023

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the Congress of the United States to pass the RU-486 suspension and review act of 2003. WHEREAS, The Clinton administration did not require proper Fed-eral Food and Drug Administration review of the medical abortion pill RU-486; and WHEREAS, Since that time at least seven American women have died as a result of the use of RU-486, most recently Holly Patterson, 18 years of age, of Livermore, California, on September 17, 2003; and WHEREAS, There is currently a bill before the Congress of the United States, H.R. 3453, 108th Cong., 1st Sess. (2003), seeking to sus-pend the use of RU-486 until the Comptroller General of the United States reviews the process by which the Food and Drug Administration approved the use of such drug: Now, therefore, Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas, the Senate concurring therein: That the Kansas Legislature urges the Congress of the United States to pass H.R. 3453, 108th Cong., 1st Sess. (2003), known as the RU-486 suspension and review act of 2003; and Be it further resolved: That the Secretary of State is hereby directed to provide an enrolled copy of this resolution to the President pro tem-pore of the United State Senate, to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives and to each member of the Kansas Congres-sional Delegation.
