## SENATE BILL No. 290 By Senator Jackson 12-15 neerning the membership of the capitol ar

9 AN ACT concerning the membership of the capitol area plaza authority; 10 amending K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 75-2237 and repealing the existing 11 section. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14 Section 1. K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 75-2237 is hereby amended to read as 15follows: 75-2237. There is hereby created the capitol area plaza authority, 16 a body politic and corporate, hereinafter referred to as the authority. The 17authority is hereby constituted a public instrumentality, and the exercise 18by the authority of the powers conferred on it by this act shall be deemed 19 and held to be the performance of an essential state governmental func-20tion. The authority shall be the successor in every way to all of the rights, 21powers, duties and obligations of the capitol area planning commission. 22 The On and after July 1, 2004, and before June 30, 2005, the authority 23shall have 12 members, and on and after July 1, 2005, the authority shall 24have 13 11 members who shall be as follows: 25(a) One member shall be a member of the house of representatives 26 appointed by the speaker. 27 (b) One member shall be a senator appointed by the president of the 28senate. 29 (c) One member shall be a member of the house of representatives 30 appointed by the minority leader of the house of representatives. 31 (d) One member shall be a senator appointed by the minority leader 32 of the senate. 33 (e) One member shall be the secretary of administration. 34 One member shall be a person representative of the city govern-(f)35 ment of Topeka appointed by the mayor thereof. 36 One member shall be a person experienced in land use planning (g) 37 appointed by the governor. 38 One member shall be the judicial administrator of the courts. (h) 39 The remaining members shall be appointed by the governor and (i) 40shall have such qualifications as the governor may deem appropriate. 41 Members serving on the authority ex officio shall serve for terms con-42 current with the office each holds. The appointive members shall serve 43 for terms of four years, except that the members of the capitol area plan-

ning commission immediately prior to the effective date of this act who were appointed by the governor shall serve as members of the capitol area plaza authority, and any unexpired portions of their respective terms of office as members of the commission shall be included in their terms of office as original members of the authority. Subsequent appointments shall be made as provided for original appointments, and any vacancy in the office of an appointed member shall be filled in the same manner as for original appointments for the unexpired terms. No successor shall be appointed as provided in this section for the office of the member ap-pointed by the governor and whose term expires June 30, 2004, and one of the members appointed by the governor and whose term expires June 30, 2005. Subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4315c and amendments thereto, the members of the authority appointed by the governor shall be so selected that all congressional districts of the state are represented no more than one member shall be a resident of the same congressional *district* on the authority. 

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 75-2237 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
