8 9 AN ACT concerning public postsecondary education; concerning certain 10 persons deemed to be residents for purposes of tuition and other fees 11 at postsecondary educational institutions. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14 Section 1. (a) Any individual who is enrolled or has been accepted 15for admission at a postsecondary educational institution as a postsecon-16 dary student shall be deemed to be a resident of Kansas for the purpose 17of tuition and fees for attendance at such postsecondary educational 18 institution. 19 (b) As used in this section: 20 (1)"Postsecondary educational institution" has the meaning ascribed 21thereto in K.S.A. 74-3201b, and amendments thereto; and 22 "individual" means a person who (A) has attended an accredited (2)23 Kansas high school for three or more years, (B) has either graduated from 24an accredited Kansas high school or has earned a general educational 25development (GED) certificate issued within Kansas, regardless of 26 whether the person is or is not a citizen of the United States of America; 27 and (C) in the case of a person without lawful immigration status, has 28filed with the postsecondary educational institution an affidavit stating 29 that the person has filed an application to legalize such person's immi-30 gration status, or will file such an application as soon as such person is 31 eligible to do so or, in the case of a person with a legal, nonpermanent 32 immigration status, has filed with the postsecondary educational institu-33 tion an affidavit stating that such person has filed an application to begin 34 the process for citizenship of the United States or will file such application 35 as soon as such person is eligible to do so. 36 The provisions of this section shall not apply to any individual who: (c)

(1) Has a valid student visa; or

(2) at the time of enrollment, is eligible to enroll in a public postse condary educational institution located in another state upon payment of
fees and tuition required of residents of such state.
