AN ACT relating to automated teller machines; requiring reverse personal identification number technology.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

- Section 1. (a) Any automated teller machine operated in this state shall be designed and programmed so that when a consumer enters such consumer's personal identification number in reverse order, the automated teller machine automatically sends an alarm to the local law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the automated teller machine location.
- (b) For the purpose of this section, "automated teller machine" means any electronic information processing device located in this state which accepts or dispenses cash in connection with a depositor's account or accounts.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
