9	AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to the transfer of territory
10	between districts.

12	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
13	Section 1. (a) The state board shall establish and implement proce-
14	dures to allow districts to resolve disputes concerning the transfer of ter-
15	ritory pursuant to K.S.A. 72-7101 et seq., and amendments thereto,
16	through a mediation process.
17	(b) The procedures adopted by the state board shall ensure that the
18	mediation process is:
19	(1) Voluntary on the part of the districts; and
20	(2) conducted by a qualified and impartial mediator who is trained in
21	effective mediation techniques.
22	(c) The state board shall maintain a list of individuals who are qual-
23	ified mediators and shall establish procedures for the appointment of a
24	mediator to help resolve disputes between the districts.
25	(d) The district requesting the transfer shall bear the cost of the me-
26	diation process.
27	(e) Each session in the mediation process shall be scheduled in a
28	timely manner and shall be held in a location that is convenient to the
29	districts.
30	(f) An agreement reached by the districts shall be set forth in a writ-
31	ten mediation agreement. Such agreement shall be included in the writ-
32 33	ten agreement or petition for transfer of territory submitted to the state
33 34	board pursuant to K.S.A. 72-7108, and amendments thereto. Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
