Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

- Section 1. K.S.A. 72-8701 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72- $8701. \ In accordance with the provisions of this act the boards of education$ of any two (2) or more school districts are hereby authorized to discuss  $issues\ relating\ to\ consolidation\ of\ such\ districts\ and\ enter\ into\ agreements$ to form one consolidated unified school district. Such meetings may be held within the boundaries of any of the districts proposing to form the  $consolidated\ district.$
- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 72-8701 is hereby repealed.Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
