9 AN ACT concerning campaign finance; establishing a limitation on total
10 expenditures for election to a legislative office.

12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. (a) From and after January 1, 2006, no person seeking
14 election to the Kansas legislature as a member of the house of represen-
15 tatives shall make any campaign expenditures in excess of the total ex-
16 penditure limitation set forth in subsection (c).

17 (b) From and after January 1, 2008, no person seeking election to the
18 Kansas legislature as a member of the Senate shall make any campaign
19 expenditures in excess of the total expenditure limitation set forth in sub-
20 section (c).

21 (c) The total aggregate of all expenditures shall not exceed R dollars
22 where R is determined mathematically as follows:

23 (1) R = the number of registered voters within the legislative district
24 if R is a multiple of 10,000; otherwise

25 (2) R = the number of registered voters within the legislative district
26 rounded upward to the next multiple of 10,000.

27 (d) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the campaign
28 finance act.

29 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
30 publication in the statute book.
