(a) Aggravated automated teller machine robbery is an au-27 tomated teller machine robbery, as defined by section 1, and amendments 28 thereto, committed by a person who is armed with a dangerous weapon 29 or who inflicts bodily harm upon any person in the course of such robbery. 30 (b) Aggravated automated teller machine robbery is a severity level 31 2, person felony. 32 (c) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas crim-33 inal code. 34 Sec. 3.
