AN ACT concerning fees for services provided by the state treasurer's office; establishing the treasurer services reimbursement fund.

12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

13 Section 1. (a) The state treasurer is hereby authorized to charge fees 14to other state agencies for the services that it provides including, but not 15limited to, banking services fees based upon the number and type of 16 transactions processed by each agency through the state's operating ac-17counts established under K.S.A. 75-4202 and amendments thereto and 18 transaction fees for processing vouchers, warrants and direct deposits, 19 except that payroll warrants shall not be subject to any fee. The fees shall 20be based upon a combination of the banking fees incurred by the trea-21surer and the operating costs for providing each service.

(b) The state treasurer shall revise its schedule of fees annually afterconsulting with various state agencies.

24(c) There is hereby established in the state treasury the treasurer 25services reimbursement fund. The fees collected under this section shall 26 be deposited in the treasurer services reimbursement fund. Moneys in 27 the treasurer services reimbursement fund may be expended for the trea-28surer's office general operating expenses in accordance with the provi-29 sions of appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and 30 reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the state treasurer or by 31 a person designated by the state treasurer.

32 (d) The director of accounts and reports shall transfer to the treasurer 33 services reimbursement fund of the state treasurer one or more amounts 34 certified by the state treasurer for expenses incurred for unemployment 35 insurance benefit warrants issued and processed and electronic transac-36 tions processed for the department of human resources payable from the 37 employment security fund, from moneys made available to the state un-38 der section 903(d) of the federal social security act, as amended, and 39 credited to the employment security fund.

40 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 41 publication in the statute book.
