Session of 2004 SENATE BILL No. 491 By Senator Pugh 2-10 AN ACT concerning voting; amending K.S.A. 25-2416 and repealing the existing section. Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 25-2416 is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-2416. (a) Voting without being qualified is knowingly and willfully:  $\frac{(a)}{(a)}$ Voting or attempting to vote at any election when not a lawfully registered voter.  $\frac{(b)}{(2)}$ Voting or offering to vote more than once at the same election. Inducing or aiding any person to vote more than once at the same election. (4) Voting or attempting to vote when such person is not lawfully present in the United States. (b) Registering voters who are not qualified to vote is knowingly and willfully registering or attempting to register persons who are not lawfully present in the United States. Voting without being qualified (c) Violation of this section is a class A misdemeanor. In addition to any other sentence imposed pursuant to this section, a person shall be fined \$1,000. Sec. 2. K.S.A. 25-2416 is hereby repealed. Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
