(a) As used in the motor vehicle drivers' license act, the following 15words and phrases shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them 16 herein: 17"Drivers' license examiner" or "examiner" means a drivers' li-(1)18 cense examiner of the division of vehicles or any person whom the direc-19 tor of vehicles has authorized, pursuant to the authority granted by this 20act, to accept applications for drivers' licenses and administer the exam-21inations required for the issuance or renewal of drivers' licenses; 22 (2)"nonresident" means every person who is not a resident of this 23state. For the purposes of the motor vehicle drivers' license act any person 24who owns, rents or leases real estate in Kansas as such person's residence 25and engages in a trade, business or profession within Kansas or registers 26 to vote in Kansas or enrolls such person's children in a school in this state 27 or purchases Kansas registration for a motor vehicle, shall be deemed a 28resident of the state of Kansas 90 days after the conditions stated in this 29 subsection commence, except that military personnel on active duty and 30 their military dependents who are residents of another state, the following 31 shall not be considered residents of the state of Kansas for the purpose 32 of this act: (A) Military personnel on active duty and their military dependents who are residents of another state; or (B) persons who are not 33 34 *lawfully present in the United States*; and 35 (3)"patrol" means the state highway patrol. 36 (b) As used in this act, the words and phrases defined by the sections 37 in article 14 of chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated and amend-38 ments thereto shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them 39 therein, unless a different meaning is ascribed to any such word or phrase 40 by subsection (a) of this section. 41 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-234a is hereby repealed. 42 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
