12 AN ACT concerning postsecondary educational institutions; relating to

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

16 Section 1. (a) On and after ~~July 1, 2005~~ **January [July] 1, 2006**, no  
17 postsecondary educational institution shall:

18 (1) Print a student or employee's social security number, or any part  
19 of the number, on the student or employee's identification card.

20 (2) Make a student or employee's social security number available by  
21 reading the magnetic strip or other encoded information on the student  
22 or employee's identification card.

23 (b) As used in this section, "postsecondary educational institution"

24 ~~(1) Print on a person's identification card, such person's social~~  
25 ~~security number or an identification number or code which contains~~  
26 ~~three or more of the same digits, in the same sequence, in such per-~~  
27 ~~son's social security number.~~

28 ~~—(2) Make available by the reading of the magnetic strip or other~~  
29 ~~encoded information on a person's identification card, such person's~~  
30 ~~social security number or an identification number or code which~~  
31 ~~contains three or more of the same digits, in the same sequence, in~~  
32 ~~such person's social security number.~~

33 [(1) No postsecondary educational institution shall print or en-  
34 code a person's social security number on or into the person's iden-  
35 tification card.

36 [(2) Any distinguishing identifier assigned to the person's iden-  
37 tification card shall be a combination of numbers or letters or both,  
38 which is unique to such person.

39 [(3) A person's distinguishing identifier shall not, in any way,  
40 be based on or depend on the person's social security number.]

41 (b) As used in this section:

42 (1) "Person" means an employee of or a student enrolled at a  
43 postsecondary educational institution.

1       (2) ***“Postsecondary educational institution”*** means and includes  
2 area vocational schools, area vocational-technical schools, community col-  
3 leges, the municipal university, state educational institutions, technical  
4 colleges and private institutions of postsecondary education.

5       Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
6 publication in the statute book.
