15Sec. 3 4. K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 40-4623 is hereby amended to read as 16 follows: 40-4623. (a) A health benefit plan that provides coverage for 17prescription drugs or devices and issues a card for claims processing and 18 an administrator of any such plan, including, but not limited to, a phar-19 macy benefits manager and a third-party administrator shall issue a card 20containing uniform prescription drug information to each person entitled 21to such card under the health benefit plan. If required for claims adju-22 dication, the uniform prescription drug information card shall specifically 23

identify and display the following information:

- 24 ANSI-BIN number; (1)
- 25(2)processor control number or group number or both;
- 26(3)card issuer identifier;
- 27(4)prescription claims processor, if different from card issuer;

28(5)cardholder identification number;

- 29(6)cardholder or insured name:
- 30 (7)claims submission names and addresses; and
- 31 (8)help desk telephone numbers.

32 (b) A uniform prescription drug information card shall be issued by

33 a health benefit plan to each person entitled to such card under the health 34 benefit plan upon enrollment and reissued upon any change in such per-
