9 AN ACT concerning cities; relating to quarterly reports of the treasurer;
10 amending K.S.A. 12-1608 and repealing the existing section.

12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. K.S.A. 12-1608 is hereby amended to read as follows: 12-
14 1608. (a) The treasurer of each city of the first or second class shall publish
15 or cause to be published in a newspaper published in such city, or if there
16 is no newspaper published in such city then in a newspaper published in
17 the county in which such city is located and having a general circulation
18 in such city, within ~~30~~ 45 days after the quarter ending in March, June,
19 September and December of each year, a statement showing the total
20 amount received into each fund and the total amount expended from
21 each fund and the cash balances of each fund at the beginning and close
22 of each quarter. Such quarterly statement shall show the amount of out-
23 standing registered warrants, temporary notes, bonds and all other obli-
24 gations and liabilities of the city.

25 (b) In the case of cities of the third class, the treasurer shall file an
26 annual statement showing the total amount received into each fund and
27 the total amount expended from each fund and the cash balances of each
28 fund at the beginning and close of each year. Such annual statement shall
29 show the amount of outstanding registered warrants, temporary notes,
30 bonds and all other obligations and liabilities of the city. The annual state-
31 ment shall be published within ~~30~~ 45 days after December 31 of each
32 year in the official city newspaper.

33 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 12-1608 is hereby repealed.

34 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
35 publication in the statute book.
