9 AN ACT concerning gaming; relating to the use of moneys derived 10 therefrom. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. (a) As used in this section: 14"Moneys" means moneys, received by or on behalf of the state, (1)15which are derived from any expanded gaming activity after the payment 16of prizes and expenses. 17(2)"Expanded gaming activity" means any casino game, video lottery 18game, electronic game or other gaming activity not excluded by this 19 section. 20"Expanded gaming activity" does not mean: (A) Parimutuel grey-(3)21hound racing or parimutuel horse racing conducted pursuant to K.S.A. 22 74-8801 et seq., and amendments thereto; or (B) bingo, instant bingo or 23 other forms of bingo conducted pursuant to K.S.A. 79-4701 et seq., and 24 amendments thereto. 25(4)"Secretary" means the secretary of the department on aging. 26 (b) There is hereby created in the state treasury the older Kansans 27services fund. All moneys shall be remitted to the state treasurer in ac-28cordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. 29Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit 30 the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit of the older Kansans 31 services fund. Such fund shall be administered by the secretary in ac-32 cordance with this section and the provisions of appropriation acts. Ex-33 penditures from the older Kansans services fund shall be made in ac-34 cordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of 35 accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the sec-36 retary and shall be used as follows: 37 (1)A portion of such moneys shall be allocated to the area agencies 38 on aging based on a funding formula established by the secretary; 39 (2) a portion of such moneys shall be awarded to support and enhance 40programs and services under the senior care act and other community-41based services programs which provide meals, in-home services and res-42pite-care services to the elderly; and 43 (3) a portion of such moneys shall be used to support and enhance  $\rm SB~555$ 

programs and services which provide assisted living services to the elderly.Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
