A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging that Federal noxious weed cost share dollars be made available for the control of noxious weeds on CRP land in the state of Kansas.

WHEREAS, noxious weeds are a continuing problem in the state of Kansas; and

WHEREAS, noxious weeds are a drain on the state of Kansas' economy; and

WHEREAS, the government of the United States has already recognized the threat of noxious weeds to agriculture and instituted several assistance programs for battling noxious weeds: Now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Kansas, the House of Representatives concurring therein: That the United States department of agriculture make additional federal cost-share dollars be made available to the state of Kansas for the control of noxious weeds on CRP land.

Be it further resolved: That the secretary Secretary of state State be directed to send enrolled copies of this resolution to the United States secretary of agriculture and to each member of the Kansas congressional delegation.
