

SENATE RESOLUTION No. 1869

A RESOLUTION congratulating and commending the Quinter High School forensic team and Coach Sue Ann Tebo for winning the 2004 Class 2A State Forensic Championship.

WHEREAS, The state meet was held on May 1, 2004, at Bethel College in Newton. Thirty-four teams across Kansas participated in the meet with six having full teams of 16 entries; and

WHEREAS, Quinter brought home two individual champions, Adrienne Ringer in informative and Britney Funk, for the second consecutive year, in prose; and
