K.S.A. 5-401 is hereby amended to read as follows: 5-401. 15(a) A written agreement to submit any existing controversy to arbitration 16 is valid, enforceable and irrevocable except upon such grounds as exist at 17law or in equity for the revocation of any contract. 18Except as provided in subsection (c), a provision in a written con-(b) 19 tract to submit to arbitration any controversy thereafter arising between 20the parties is valid, enforceable and irrevocable except upon such grounds 21as exist at law or in equity for the revocation of any contract. 22 (c) The provisions of subsection (b) shall not apply to: (1) Contracts 23 of insurance, except for those contracts between insurance companies, 24 including reinsurance contracts; (2) Contracts between an employer and 25employees, or their respective representatives; or (3) (2) any provision of 26 a contract providing for arbitration of a claim in tort. 27 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 5-401 is hereby repealed. 28 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 29 publication in the statute book.
