AN ACT relating to postsecondary educational institutions; providing for the state board of regents to develop certain performance indicators.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The state board of regents shall develop performance indicators for all postsecondary educational institutions in this state. Such performance indicators shall strive to gauge the success of the educational institutions in preparing students for career placement or pursuit of subsequent educational or career experience. The board of regents may select such performance indicators, including the method of objective measurement thereof, as the board deems most appropriate and may utilize differing performance indicators for individual postsecondary educational programs or degrees, educational institutions or types of postsecondary institutions.

- (b) On or before July 1, 2006, the state board of regents shall provide to the legislative educational planning committee a progress report on the development of performance indicators provided for in subsection (a). Commencing in 2007, the board of regents annually shall provide the governor and the legislature a report of the results of the achievement on performance indicators for each postsecondary educational institution and degree or certificate program.
- (c) As used in this section, "postsecondary educational institution" shall have the meaning ascribed thereto in K.S.A. 74-3201b and amendments thereto.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
