10AN ACT concerning county treasurers; relating to terms of office; amending K.S.A. 19-501 and repealing the existing section. 11 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. K.S.A. 19-501 is hereby amended to read as follows: 19-15 501. Each county treasurer elected at the general election in $\frac{1976}{2004}$ 16 shall serve until the second Tuesday in October of 1981 Monday in Jan-17uary of 2009 and until a successor is elected and gualified. At the general election in 1980 2008, and every four (4) years thereafter, a county trea-1819surer shall be elected in each county for a term of four (4) years, com-20mencing on the second Tuesday in October Monday in January following 21the election, and until a successor is elected and qualified. Such county 22 treasurer shall, Before entering upon the duties, of the office the county 23 treasurer shall execute to the state of Kansas a corporate surety bond 24 issued by a company authorized to do business in this state and approved 25by the board of county commissioners in an amount of not less than 26 twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) \$25,000. Such bond, with the ap-27proval of the board endorsed thereon by the clerk, shall be filed in the 28 office of the county clerk. In the event If the board of commissioners 29 shall not be in session *does not meet* in time for any county treasurer to 30 present such bond for their approval as above specified, or such county 31treasurer shall be unable, for any reason, is unable to present such bond 32 at any regular meeting of the board after due notice of such county trea-33 surer's election, such county treasurer may present such bond to the 34 ehairman chairperson or clerk of the board for approval, and the approval 35 endorsed thereon shall have the same effect as if done *approved* by the 36 board of county commissioners. In the event If the amount of the bond 37 is approved by only the chairman *chairperson* or the clerk of the board, 38 it shall not be less than twice the amount of all moneys directed by the 39 board to be levied in the county during the previous year. 40 K.S.A. 19-501 is hereby repealed. Sec. 2.
