AN ACT concerning the attorney general; establishing an office of public 1011integrity. 1213 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. (a) There is hereby established within the office of the 1415 attorney general the office of public integrity. Such office shall receive 16the written complaints from individuals alleging violations of the open records act, K.S.A. 45-215 et seq., and amendments thereto, and open 1718meetings act, K.S.A. 75-4317 et seq., and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of a complaint under subsection (a), the public in-19(b) 20tegrity officer may: 21(1) Refer the complaint to the appropriate county or district attor-22 ney's office for investigation and possible action; or 23 (2) investigate the complaint to determine if a violation has occurred. If, after investigation, the public integrity officer determines that: 24 25No action need be taken on the complaint, a letter shall be sent (A) 26to the parties detailing such officer's conclusions; or 27 a violation has occurred, such officer's conclusion and underlying (B) 28 reasons shall be made public in a written statement. 29 On or before December 31 January 15, of each year, each county (c) 30 and district attorney shall report to the attorney general all complaints 31 received during the preceding fiscal year concerning the open records act 32 and open meetings act and the disposition of each complaint. The attorney general shall compile information received pursuant 33 (d) 34 to this subsection with information relating to investigations conducted 35 by the public integrity office and publish a yearly abstract of such information listing by name the public agencies which are the subject of such 36 37 complaints or investigations. Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 38
