11 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

12Section 1. (a) On and after the effective date of this act, any provision 13 of a restrictive covenant which requires the use of wood shingles or wood shakes as a roof covering material for any residential dwelling is hereby 1415 declared to be against public policy and such provision shall be void and 16 unenforceable unless such covenant also allows for the use of an alternative material which is comparable in appearance, flame resistant or 1718retardant, and meets or exceeds any fire prevention standards established by any municipal building code which has been adopted as required by 19 20law applicable to such residential dwelling. 21(b) The provisions of this section shall apply to any restrictive cove-22 nant in existence on the effective date of this act. 23 The provisions of this section shall not affect the enforceability of (c) 24 a restrictive covenant which regulates or restricts the color, style, dimen-25sion or other aesthetic characteristics of roofing material to be used on a 26 residential dwelling if such restrictive covenant meets the requirements

- 27 of subsection (a).
- 28 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 29 publication in the statute book.
