9 AN ACT concerning civil procedure; relating to docket fees for post-10decree motions; amending K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 60-1621 and repealing 11the existing section. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 60-1621 is hereby amended to read as 15follows: 60-1621. (a) In any action pursuant to article 16 of chapter 60 of 16 the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, no post-decree motion petitioning for a change in legal custody, residency, visitation 1718rights or parenting time, or for a modification of child support shall be 19 filed or docketed in the district court without payment of a docket fee in 20the amount of \$21 to the clerk of the district court. 21A poverty affidavit may be filed in lieu of a docket fee as estab-(b) 22 lished in K.S.A. 60-2001, and amendments thereto. 23 (c) The docket fee shall be the only costs assessed in each case for services of the clerk of the district court and the sheriff. The docket fee 24 shall be disbursed in accordance with subsection (f) of K.S.A. 20-362, and 2526 amendments thereto. 27 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 60-1621 is hereby repealed. 28Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
