AN ACT concerning hunting; amending K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 32-920 andrepealing the existing section.

15 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

16Section 1. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 32-920 is hereby amended to read as 17follows: 32-920. (a) Except as provided by subsection (e) subsections (e) and (f), no person who is born on or after July 1, 1957, and is 16 or more 1819years of age shall hunt in this state on land other than such person's own 20land unless the person has been issued a certificate of completion of an 21approved hunter education course. If such person is required by law to 22obtain a hunting license, the person shall attest to or exhibit proof of 23 completion of such course to the person issuing the license at the time 24 of purchasing the license. If such person is not required by law to obtain 25a hunting license, is less than 27 years of age but 16 or more years of age 26or is less than 16 but 12 or more years of age and hunting without adult 27supervision, the person shall be in possession of the person's certificate 28 of completion of such course while hunting. A person may purchase for 29 another person, under rules and regulations adopted by the secretary in 30 accordance with K.S.A. 32-805 and amendments thereto, a lifetime hunt-31ing or combination hunting and fishing license without the license recip-32 ient's first having been issued a certificate of completion of an approved 33 hunter education course. 34 A person less than 12 years of age shall not hunt unless under the (b) 35 direct supervision of an adult who is 18 or more years of age.

(c) A person who is 12 or more years of age but less than 16 years of age and who has not been issued a certificate of completion of an approved hunter education course shall not hunt unless under the direct supervision of an adult who is 18 or more years of age.

(d) A person less than 14 years of age shall not be issued a permit to
take big game using a bow unless the person submits to the secretary
evidence satisfactory to the secretary of completion of a bow hunting
safety education course.

1 (e) Prior to July 1, 2005, completion of an approved hunter education 2 course shall not be required to obtain a special controlled shooting area 3 hunting license valid only for licensed controlled shooting areas.

4 (f) A person shall not be required to obtain a certificate pursuant to 5 this section if such person is a member of the United States armed forces

6 who has successfully completed basic military training and advanced in-

7 dividual military training or has received an honorable discharge or is

8 retired from the United States armed forces. At the time of purchasing a

9 hunting license, such person shall be required to exhibit proof, satisfactory

10 to the secretary, that such person qualifies for the exemption provided by
