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9 AN ACT concerning pharmacists; relating to renal dialysis facility phar-10 macist consultants; amending K.S.A. 65-1661 and repealing the exist-11 ing section. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. K.S.A. 65-1661 is hereby amended to read as follows: 65-15 1661. (a) A medicare approved renal dialysis facility which keeps pre-16 scription drugs as a part of the services provided by such facility shall 17obtain a registration from the board as a renal dialysis facility pharmacy. 18Application for such registration shall be made in accordance with pro-19cedures established by the board. All fees applicable to registration of a 20pharmacy, and the renewal of such registration, shall apply to the regis-21tration of a renal dialysis facility pharmacy. 22 (b) A registered renal dialysis facility pharmacy shall be supervised 23 by a pharmacist consultant. The pharmacist consultant shall act as the 24 pharmacist in charge. If a pharmacist consultant is not available to a reg-25istered renal dialysis facility pharmacy, the board shall provide or make 26 arrangements for a pharmacist to act as a pharmacist consultant for such 27 pharmacy and in the interim shall assist such pharmacy in locating a suit-28 able pharmacist consultant. 29 (c) A renal dialysis facility pharmacy which is part of a medicare ap-30 proved renal dialysis facility shall be deemed to be in compliance with 31rules and regulations of the state board of pharmacy, except that the board may adopt rules and regulations applicable to such pharmacy which es-32 33 tablish labeling requirements for prescription medications delivered by 34 such pharmacy. 35 (d) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the pharmacy 36 act of the state of Kansas. 37 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 65-1661 is hereby repealed. 38 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 39 publication in the statute book.
