9 AN ACT relating to consumer protection; concerning credit and debit 10 card receipts; amending K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 50-669b and repealing the 11 existing section. 1213 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 50-669b is hereby amended to read as 15follows: 50-669b. (a) No supplier which accepts credit cards or debit cards 16 shall print more than the last five digits of the credit card or debit card 17account number or print the credit card or debit card expiration date on 18a credit card or debit card receipt issued to the cardholder. 19(b) This section shall apply only to receipts that are electronically 20printed and shall not apply to transactions in which the sole means of 21recording the credit card or debit card number is by handwriting or by 22 an imprint or copy of the credit card or debit card. 23 This section applies on July 1, 2003, to any cash register or other (c) 24 machine or device that electronically prints receipts for credit card or 25debit card transactions and is placed into service on or after July 1, 2003, 26 and on July 1, 2004, to any cash register or other machine or device that 27electronically prints receipts for credit card or debit card transactions and 28is placed into service prior to July 1, 2003. 29 (d) Suppliers which accept credit cards or debit cards shall print the 30 name of the business on a credit card or debit card receipt issued to the 31cardholder. The business name printed on the receipt shall be the name 32 as advertised, or if doing business under a name different than the ad-33 vertised business name, the "doing business as" business name shall be 34 printed on the receipt. 35 $\frac{d}{d}$ (e) Violation of this section shall be deemed an unconscionable 36 act as defined by K.S.A. 50-627, and amendments thereto. 37 (e) (f) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas 38 consumer protection act. 39 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 50-669b is hereby repealed. 40 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 41publication in the statute book.
