9 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; concerning air bags. 10 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 11 12Section 1. (a) As used in this section: 13 (1) "Air bag" means an inflatable restraint system or portion of an inflatable restraint system installed in a motor vehicle; 1415"previously deployed air bag" means an inflatable restraint system (2)16or portion of the system that has been activated or inflated as a result of 17a collision or other incident involving the vehicle; and 18"nondeployed salvage air bag" means an inflatable restraint sys-(3)19tem that has not been previously activated or inflated as a result of a 20collision or other incident involving the vehicle. 21It shall be unlawful for any person who, without the knowledge (b) 22 of the vehicle's owner or the person requesting the installation, reinstal-23 lation or replacement of a motor vehicle air bag, to install or reinstall any 24 air bag or other component of the vehicle's inflatable restraint system 25knowing that the air bag installation is not in accordance with federal 26safety regulations applicable to that specific line-make, model and model 27 year vehicle. 28(c) It shall be unlawful for any person who, without the knowledge 29 of the vehicle's owner or the person requesting the installation, reinstal-30 lation or replacement of a motor vehicle air bag, to install, reinstall or 31replace a motor vehicle air bag or other component of the vehicle's in-32 flatable restraint system knowing that the air bag was a previously de-33 ployed air bag or a nondeployed salvage air bag. Any such previously 34 deployed air bag or nondeployed salvage air bag which is installed or 35 reinstalled shall conform to the original equipment manufacturer require-36 ments applicable to that specific line-make, model and model year 37 vehicle. 38 It shall be unlawful for any person to: (1) Install material that is (d) 39 not an air bag in the space where the air bag that is part of an inflatable 40 restraint system is to be replaced; or (2) install a fake air bag cover. 41(e) It shall be unlawful for any person to sell a previously deployed 42air bag or a nondeployed salvage air bag which does not conform to the 43 original equipment manufacturer requirements applicable to that specific
