9 AN ACT relating to alternative-fueled motor vehicles; concerning the 10 state fleet; amending K.S.A. 75-4616 and repealing the existing section. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 75-4616 is hereby amended to read as follows: 75-13 144616. (a) As used in this section, "alternative-fueled vehicle" and "light-15duty motor vehicle" have the meanings provided by 42 U.S.C. 13211. 16The following percentages For model year 2005 and thereafter, (b) 1775% of new light-duty motor vehicles acquired annually for the state fleet, including agencies thereof, shall be alternative-fueled motor vehicles: 1819(1) Of the motor vehicles acquired in model year 1996, 10%; 20-(2) of the motor vehicles acquired in model year 1997, 15%; 21of the motor vehicles acquired in model year 1998, 25%; -(3)-22 (4) of the motor vehicles acquired in model year 1999, 50%; and 23 - (5) of the motor vehicles acquired in model year 2000 and thereafter, 24 75%. 25The provisions of this section shall apply only to light-duty motor <del>(e)</del> 26 vehicles in the state fleet which are used primarily within a metropolitan 27 statistical area or a consolidated metropolitan statistical area, as estab-28lished by the bureau of the census, with a 1980 population of 250,000 or 29 more, shall be alternative-fueled motor vehicles. 30 The following percentages of new light-duty motor vehicles ac-(c)31quired annually for the state fleet, including agencies thereof, shall be 32 alternative-fueled motor vehicles: 33 (1)*Of the motor vehicles acquired in model year 2006, 10%;* 34 (2)of the motor vehicles acquired in model year 2007, 20%; 35 (3)of the motor vehicles acquired in model year 2008, 30%; 36 (4)of the motor vehicles acquired in model year 2009, 40%; and 37 (5)of the motor vehicles acquired in model year 2010 and thereafter, 38 50%. 39 The provisions of this subsection shall apply only to light-duty motor 40 vehicles in the state fleet which are used primarily outside of a metro-41politan statistical area or a consolidated metropolitan statistical area, as 42established by the bureau of the census, with a 1980 population of 250,000 43 or more.
